EURO CUP – NATIONAL WASZP 2021

YACHT CLUB DE CARNAC **BAIE DE QUIBERON** From 30th of July until the 3rd of August 2021 GRADE 4

[NP] denotes a rule that shall not be grounds for protest by a boat. [DP] denotes a rule for which the penalty is at the discretion of the Jury and may be less than a disgualification. This modified RSS 60.1(a).

- RULES 1
- 1.1 - The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)
- -FFVoile Prescriptions to RRS 2021-2024 translated for non-francophone competitors (in 1.2 Appendix)
- 1.3 - French Federal rules
- WASZP class Rules will apply 1.4
- In case of conflict between languages, the French version will prevail. 1.5

3 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

- 3.2 [DP] [NP] From the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency situation, a boat shall not transmit or received vocals information that are not available to all boats.

ELIGIBILITY AND REGISTRATION

- 4.1 Regatta is open to all boats of the WASZP Class.
- 4.2 Documents needed for the registration/ 4.2.1
 - a) each crew member must have a FFVOILE License :
 - Either the license Club FFVOILE stamps « competition »
 - Either the license Club FFVOILE stamps « adhesion » or « pratiquant » provided with a valid health certificate of less than one year validity.



	 b) For each crew member without a FFVoile License been foreign or French: a justification of being member of a national Authority, part of World Sailing Valid insurance in responsibility with a minimal coverage two millions of Euros. An health certificate proving that the crew member is fit for sailing in competition. This certificate, in English or French, must be less than one year c) a parental authorization for any minor crew member
4.2.2	For the boat: - A measurement or conformity certificate. - Authorization of advertising (if necessary).
4.3	The eligible boats may registered by filling the forms and sending them , together with entry fee , at yacht Club de Carnac port en dro BP30 56340 Carnac up to July 30 th 2021.
4.4	Boats may registered at https://www.yccarnac.com/regates-morbihan/national-waszp et /
4.5	In order to be registered a boat shall have totally fulfil the requirements and have paid the entry fee.
4.6	From the 16th of july all late entries will be penalised of an additional fee of 40€.
4.7	The regatta will be open to 60 WASZP only.

5 ENTRY FEE

5.1 Following fee must be paid:

6 ADVERTISING

- 6.1 [DP] [NP] Boats must display advertising supplied by the Organizing Authority (OA)
- 6.2 [DP] [NP] OA may provide bibs to be wearied by competitors as authorized by Advertising Code of World Sailing.

7 SCHEDULE

8.3 Number of races:

Between 2 and 5 races are planned per day. However 3 additional races may be planned each day in case of planning not fulfilled.

All boats must be back ashore at the sunset (as per RRS) been 21h43.

8.4 For the last day of the regatta no warning signal will be made after 16h00.

9 EQUIPMENT CONTROLE

9.1 Each boat shall either show or valid the proof of a relevant measurement certificate.

11 LOCATION

11.1 The race location is marked in appendix.

12 PENALTY SYSTEM

RRS 44.1 is changed so that the two-turn penalty is replaced by one turn penalty.

14 SCORING

2 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

14.2a) When fewer than 3 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of
her race scores.

b) When from 3 to 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

c) When 9 or more races have been completed, a boat4s series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

15 SUPPORT BOATS

15.1 [DP] [NP] All support boats registered in the organisation shall clearly bear the ID provided by the AO, at all time when at sea.

15.2 All support boat shall comply with RRS3.

16 RENTED OR LOANED BOAT

A rented or loaned boat may have national ID or sail number not in conformity with the Class Rules, providing that this situation have been approved by the Race Committee prior to the first race.

17 PARKING PLACE

[DP] [NP] Boats must keep the allocated parking place when ashore.

18 DATA PROTECTION

18.1 Right to use name and likeness:

In entering and participating in this event each competitor grants to the OA, the Class, The French Sailing Federation, and sponsors the absolute right, authority and permission in perpetuity to make, use, distribute, broadcast, edit, re-format, publish and show, from time to time and at their discretion, in any media, any motion pictures, still pictures, audio, and live taped or film, text television and other reproduction of him/her, his/her boat, and his/her interviews made at the venue or on the water during the whole event, for all use linked to promote the sailing activity and for all purposes without compensation.

18.2 Right to use personal competitor's data

In entering and participating in this event, each competitor and its legal representatives grants and authorised the FFVOILE (French Sailing Federation) and its sponsors, the OA to use and keep competitor's personal data. These data could be used and published by the OA, The FFVOILE and its sponsors. These data could be used for software development or for marketing purpose. By contacting FFVOILE , either by <u>dpo@ffvoile.fr</u> or by writing to the FFVoile, any competitor having given personal data to the FFVOILE, may have access to its data, may request modifications or removal of such data , in accordance with the law for the protection of personal data.

19 RISK STATEMENT

RRS 3 note that : « the responsability for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone. Sailing is by nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that.

These risks involved strong winds, hard sea, rapid changes in weather conditions, equipment failure, mistake in sailing bad navigation from other boats, loss of equilibrium due to an instable surface, and tiredness may increase the risk of injury. The risks of damaging equipment and/or physical injuries are directly linked to the sailing sport.

20 PRICES

Prices will be given to the 3 first boat of the ranking. Other prices may be given by the OA

ANNEXE PRESCRIPTIONS FEDERALES

FFVoile Prescriptions to RRS 2021-2024 translated for non-francophone competitors

FFVoile Prescription to **RRS 25.1** (*Notice of race, sailing instructions and signals*):

For events graded 4 and 5, standard notices of race and sailing instructions including the specificities of the event shall be used. Events graded 4 may have dispensation for such requirement, after receipt of FFVoile approval, received before the notice of race has been published.

For events graded 5, posting of sailing instructions will be considered as meeting the requirements of RRS 25.1 application.

(*) FFVoile Prescription to **RRS 64.4** (Decisions on protests concerning class rules):

The protest committee may ask the parties to the protest, prior to checking procedures, a deposit covering the cost of checking arising from a protest concerning class rules.

(*) FFVoile Prescription to RRS 67 (Damages):

Any question or request related to damages arising from an incident occurred while a boat was bound by the Racing Rules of Sailing depends on the appropriate courts and cannot be examined and dealt by a protest committee.

A boat that retires from a race or accepts a penalty does not, by that such action, admit liability for damages.

(*) FFVoile Prescription to RRS 70. 5 (Appeals and requests to a national authority):

The denial of the right of appeal is subject to the written approval of the Fédération Française de Voile, received before publishing the notice of race. This approval shall be posted on the official notice board during the event.

(*) FFVoile Prescription to RRS 76.1 (Exclusion of boats or competitors)

An organizing authority or race committee shall not reject or cancel the entry of a boat or exclude a competitor eligible under the notice of race and sailing instructions for an arbitrary reason.

(*) FFVoile Prescription to RRS 78.1 (Compliance with class rules; certificates):

The boat's owner or other person in charge shall, under his sole responsibility, make sure moreover that his boat complies with the equipment and security rules required by the laws, by-laws and regulations of the Administration.

(*) FFVoile Prescription to RRS 86.3 (Changes to the racing rules):

An organizing authority wishing to change a rule listed in RRS 86.1(a) in order to develop or test new rules shall first submit the changes to the FFVoile, in order to obtain its written approval and shall report the results to FFVoile after the event. Such approval shall be mentioned in the notice of race and in the sailing instructions and shall be posted on the official notice board during the event.

(*) FFVoile Prescription to RRS 88.2 (Changes to prescriptions):

Prescriptions of the FFVoile shall not be changed in the notice of race and sailing instructions, except for events for which an international jury has been appointed.

In such case, the prescriptions marked with an asterisk (*) shall not be changed in the notice of race and sailing instructions. (The official translation of the prescriptions, downloadable on the FFVoile website <u>www.ffvoile.fr</u>, shall be the only translation used to comply with RRS 90.2(b)).

(*) FFVoile Prescription to RRS 91(b) (Protest committee):

The appointment of an international jury meeting the requirements of Appendix N is subject to prior written approval of the Fédération Française de Voile. Such approval shall be posted on the official notice board during the event.
