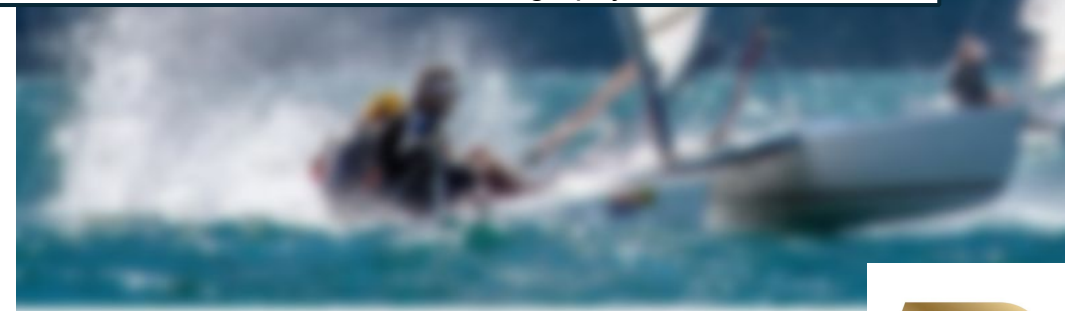

BEFORE YOU DEPART FOR CARNAC

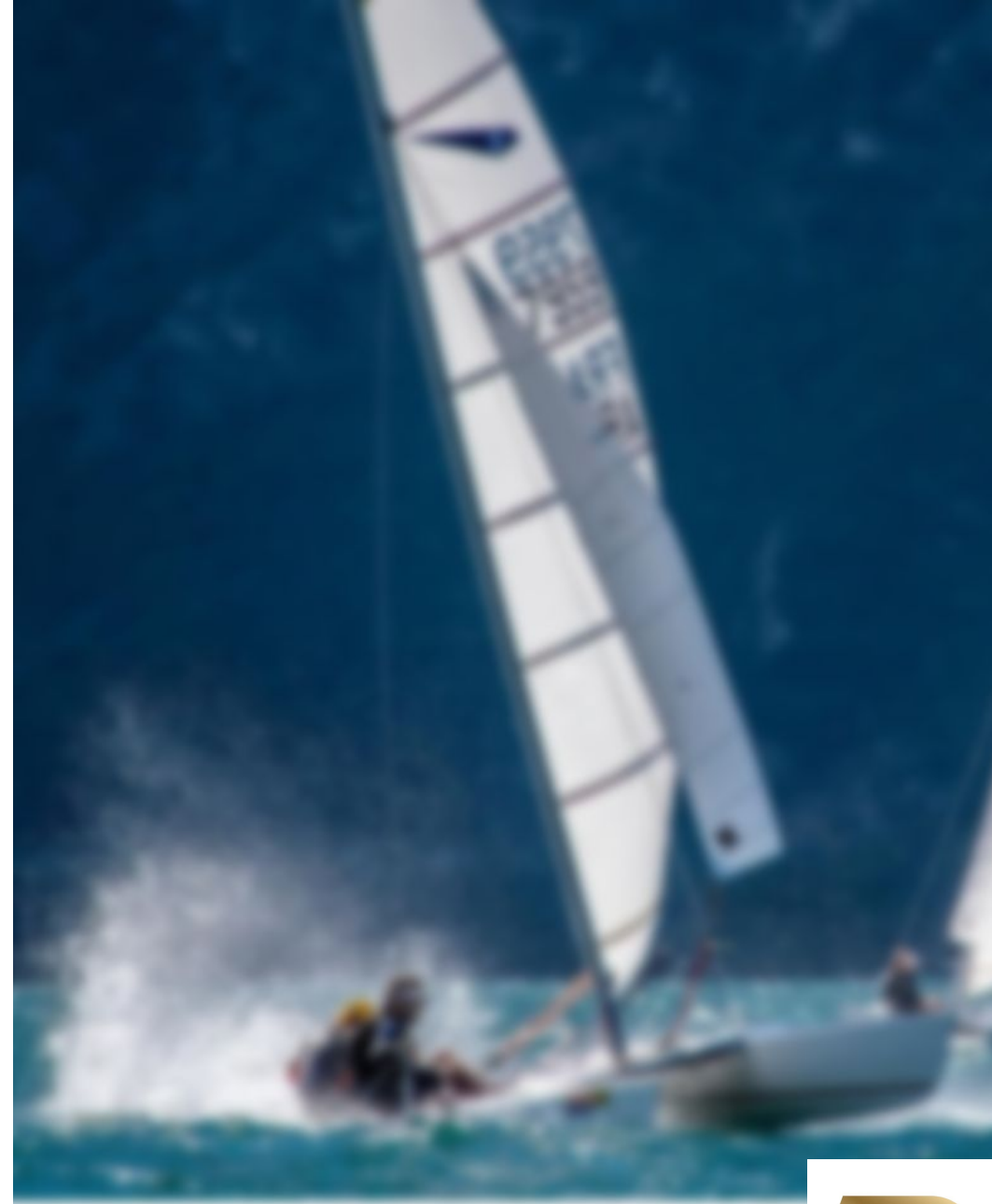
- Carefully reread the Notice of Race and ensure you comply with all administrative requirements:
https://www.afidart.fr/XXVmondial/images/AC_DART18_WC_V8.pdf
- Thoroughly check your boat: is it complete and compliant with the measurement rules? Are your wires in good condition? Do you have all the necessary navigation equipment? nationality letters on your sail?
- We recommend marking your road trailer and launching trolley with your sail number.

Spare parts and repairs:

- Nénuphar, Dart 18 France dealer, will have a spare parts stand on site throughout the championship. However, it is not planned that they will carry out GRP or gelcoat repairs on the hulls.
- If a need is identified, order the spare parts or equipment you will need well in advance.

Mandatory documents:

- For French competitors: a valid FFVoile Competition licence.
- For foreign competitors: civil liability insurance covering at least €1,000,000 as well as a Medical Certificate of no contraindication to competitive sailing.
- All competitors must be members of the Dart class in their country. For the French and Belgians, membership of AFIDART is required.

YOUR ARRIVAL

If you plan to arrive before 3 July, please notify YCC in advance to receive specific instructions.

From 3 July:

At night:

Proceed to the end of Avenue de l'Atlantique. Enter the car park opposite and leave your trailer where you can, without obstructing access for other competitors.

During the day:

- Report to our Welcome Committee who will guide you.
- Drop off your trailer and immediately take your car out again.
- Go to the registration office to confirm your registration. Opening hours: Friday from 1pm to 6pm and Saturday from 10am to 5pm.
- Assemble your boat as quickly as possible, fully complete, ready to be measured, with the mast number in place. You will be on tarmac; remember to bring protection for your hulls.
- Dismantle your trailer box if you wish. Trailers will be parked a 30-minute walk from the boat park. You can also bring a cover and keep your equipment on the boat. The boat park will be guarded at night, from the evening of 3 July to the morning of 11 July.
- **Take your trailer out again to bring it to the trailer car park.**
- **The trailer car park will not be guarded, so remember your lock.**
 - Find the measurement team as quickly as possible.
 - **For young crews: please have your bank details ready to benefit from the registration refund.**

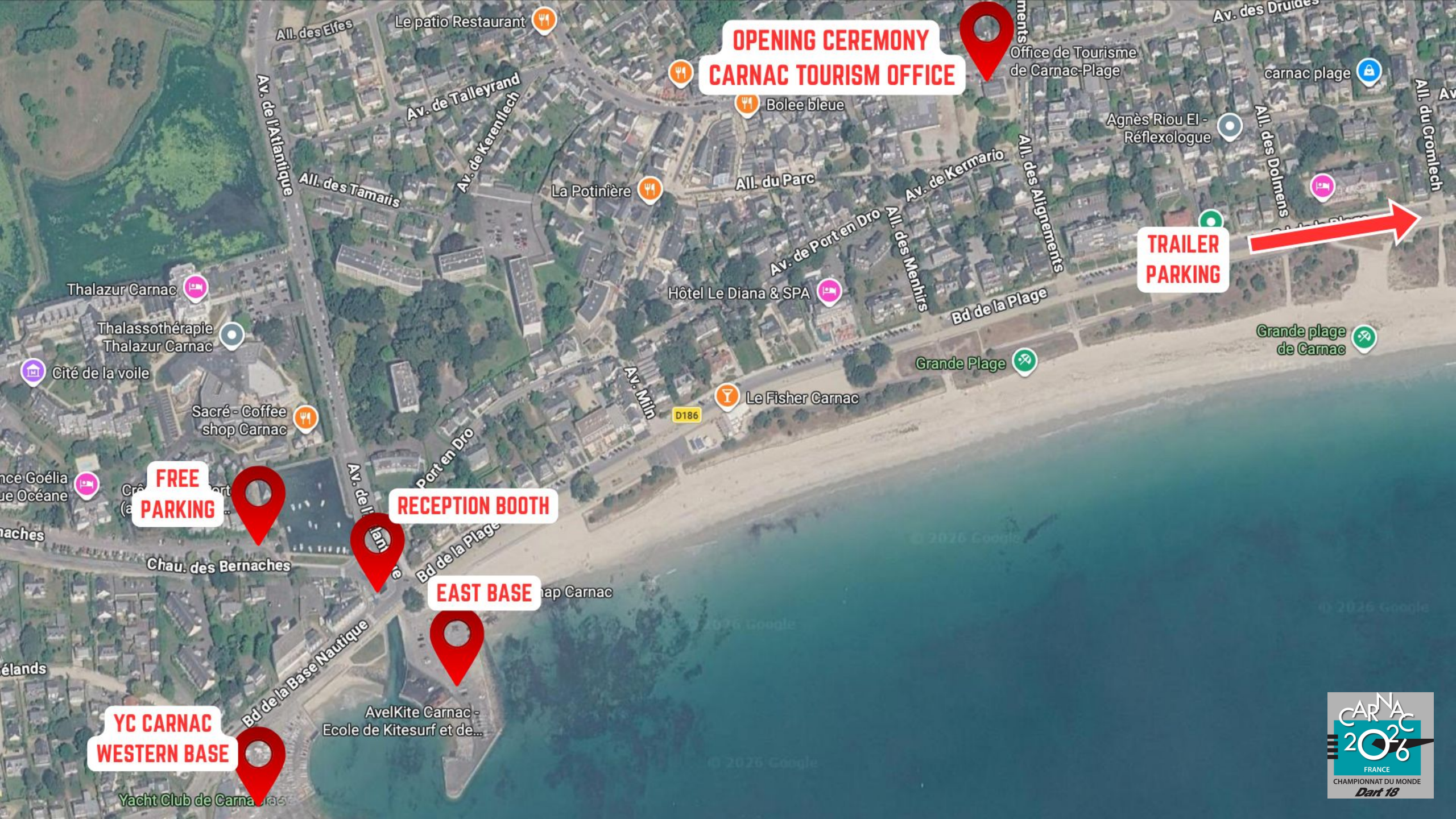



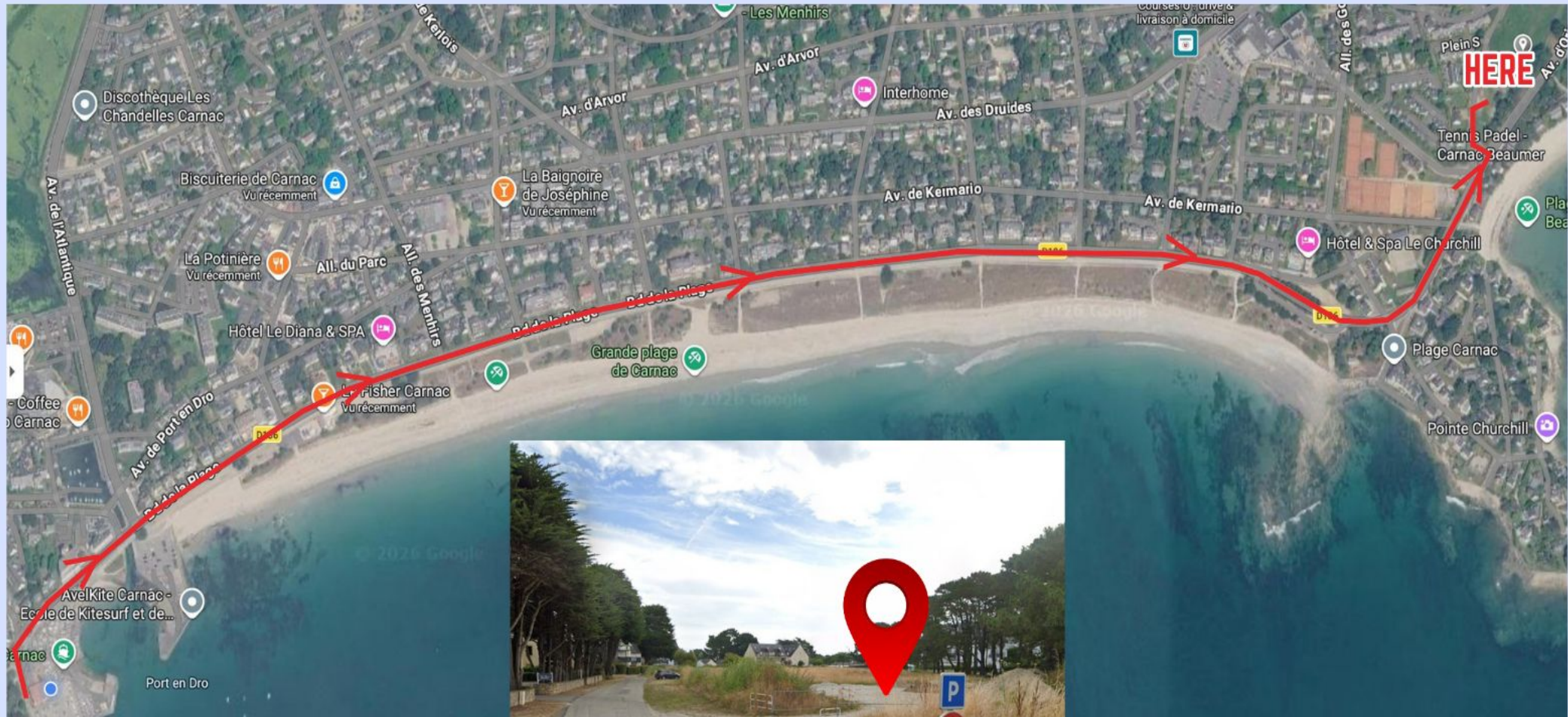

ORGANISATION RULES

Boat parking rules: please respect these few fundamentals:

- Always leave your boat in the originally assigned spot
- Do not block traffic in the aisles or on the ramp
- Place your launching trolley in the designated area, or at your spot
- Be prepared for launching; it can take some time
- Rinsing trays will be made available to you.
- ... and thank you for keeping the area clean

Car parking:

We are not the only ones who love Carnac in July. Some areas near the club offer free parking. Other areas are paid ... and regularly checked (beware of the removal service)

How to identify yourself:

- Your welcome package contains one wristband per competitor (and registered companion). It is marked with your mast number.
- Wear this wristband all week. It will give you access to all our services and events and will be mandatory!
- **The wristband will allow you to be served at the bar. Do not lose it!!!**



BOAT SRUTINEERING PROCEDURE

Our Technical Committee team will go from boat to boat to inspect them all (or re-inspect if a follow-up visit is needed).

To facilitate and streamline this operation, please ensure that your boat is perfectly ready to be inspected:

- boat fully assembled, rigged, including fittings
- rudders and steering system in place
- mainsail (with battens inserted) and jib ready to be unfurled, out of the bag
- sticker with mast number in place
- no canopy or cover
- a crew member present (understanding English or French)

If compliant, the Technical Committee will mark your boat, sign your measurement sheet and keep it for administration.

If non-compliant, you will be able to bring your boat into compliance, then call back the Technical Committee

You may be asked to fill a self-certification compliance sheet. Watch the website.

The inspection checks that your boat complies with the Dart 18 Class Rules. Your boat may be re-inspected during the Championship. For technical details, please refer to the Dart Class Rules (IDA Class Rules).

Thank you for helping us maintain our One-Design Class status.

Inspection by the Technical Committee does not guarantee that your boat is safe and seaworthy. IDA, Afidart, YCC and all organisers of this Championship disclaim any responsibility regarding the condition of your boat.

BAR OPERATION

The YCC bar is run during the Dart World Championship by a team of Afidart and YCC volunteers; thanks to them.

The bar serves: coffee and tea (in the morning), water, soft drinks, beer, cider and wine. It will be open:

- In the morning before the races from 10am to 12pm
- From the return of the race... and until late in the evening during our parties

An additional refreshment bar may be installed in the marquee.

Payment for drinks at the bar is made only with tokens. Tokens can be paid for by card only, during the bar's opening hours.

Please return your empty glasses to the bar to help with operations.



SANDWICH SHOP

Our partner, La Boulange, and the team of volunteers offer you a daily sandwich service.

The sandwich menu is available at the registration office, then at the bar. You can then:

- Choose from the choice of four sandwiches
- Order for the next day (or for the week)
- Please note: payment by card only.
- Order times: Friday from 1pm to 6pm, Saturday from 10am to 5pm, other days from 10am to 12pm
- Delivery hours at the bar: from Saturday to Friday from 10am to 12pm
- No delivery or order taking on Wednesday

- **Promoting inclusion:** promoting diversity, respect for all and the values upheld by the French Sailing Federation.

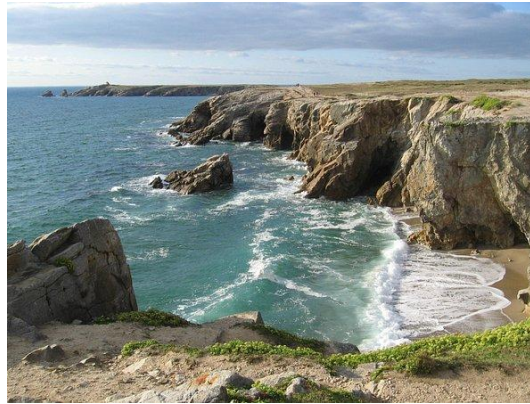
We are counting on every competitor to contribute to these initiatives and make this event a sporting, friendly and environmentally responsible occasion!
