Protest alleging contact between boats, with damage.

Procedural Matters, (Conflicts of Interest, parties not present, extending time limits)

The protestee was misidentified in the hearing request form and the boat involved in the incident was GBR 5734.

Facts found:

1. Before the hearing, FRA 6287 asked to withdraw the protest as GBR 5734 took a One-Turn Penalty.
2. The contact caused gelcoat scratches on the hull of FRA 6287.
