Request for redress alleging an improper action of the Race Committee.

Procedural Matters, (Conflicts of Interest,, parties not present, extending time limits)

- ITA 2560 was not present when the hearing commenced. The International Jury called her twice on her phone but received no answer.
- ITA 2560 did not come to the hearing, the hearing proceeded in accordance with RRS 63.1(b).

Facts found:

- In race 3, which was sailed on 07 July, ITA 2560 was scored DNE by the Race Committee due to a breach of RRS 30.4's third sentence.
- ITA 2560 filed a scoring inquiry on 07 July at 22:00 claiming that she had been incorrectly scored DNE.
- The Race Committee gave her answer to ITA 2560 on 08 July at 14:30, which was to make no change to her score.
- ITA 2560 filed this request for redress based on the same claim on 09 July at 15:05.

Conclusion & Rules:

- ITA 2560 failed to deliver the request for redress as soon as reasonably possible after the relevant information was available, as required by RRS 61.2(b)(3).
- There was no good reason for the International Jury to extend the time.

Decision:

The request for redress is invalid under RRS 61.3, and the hearing is closed under RRS 63.4(a)(1).
